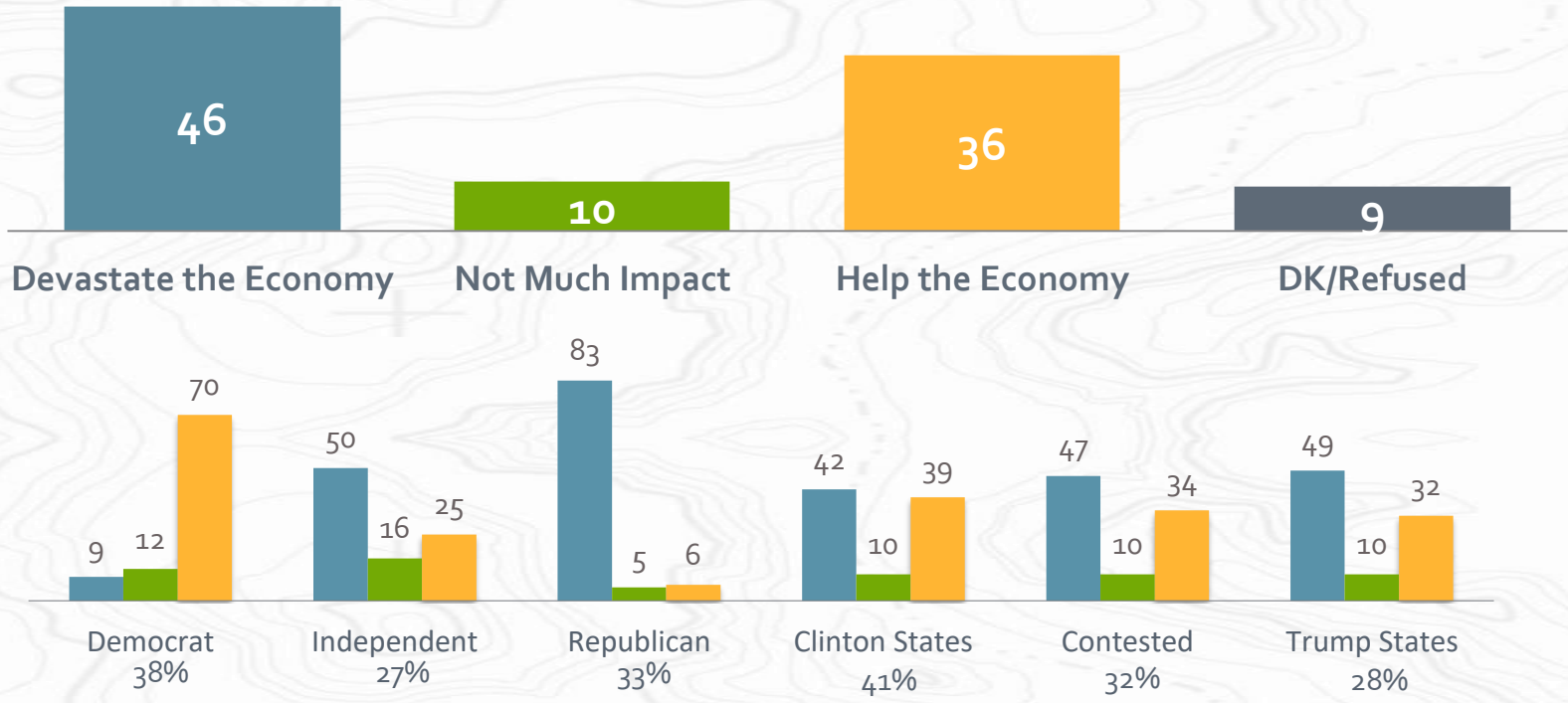
# BIDEN'S \$3 TRILLION TAX PLAN

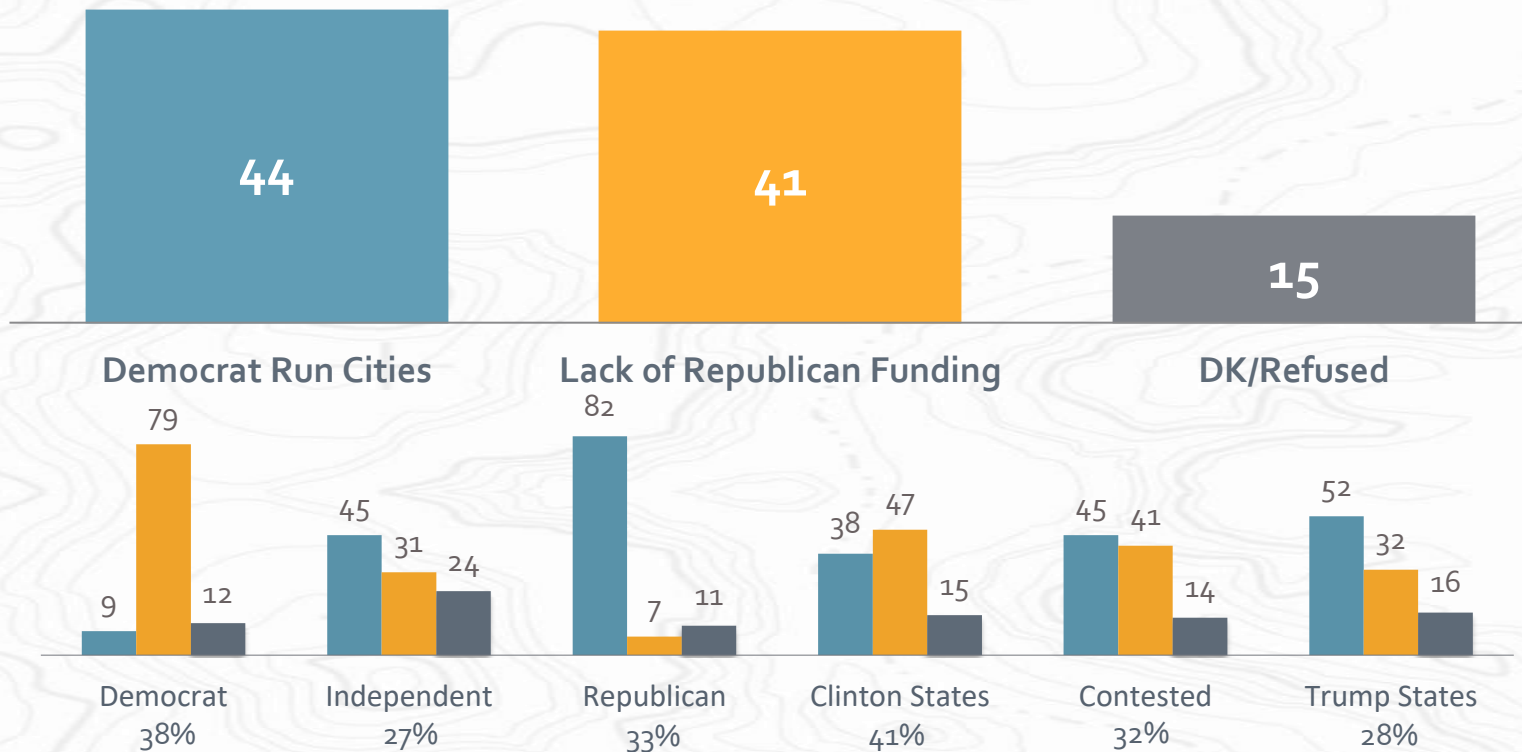


# BLAME FOR CIVIL UNREST
